Please join us in our regular worship service on Sunday, November 22, as we hold our annual Thanksgiving In-Gathering! This is an opportunity for Christ Church members and friends to give back to those in need in our immediate community.

We will be collecting non-perishable food items to help replenish the Christ Church Food Pantry. The Food Pantry fills a huge need in our community, both for the homeless and those living in need. Help us stock our Food Pantry with items that can be used to cook a meal on a stove, as well as items that do not have to be heated (self-heating soup, tuna, crackers, and cheese). Please do not bring items that are expired or unreasonable for a family to cook (avoid salad dressings, marinades, and other “back-of-the-pantry” items). The children of Christ Church will bring the donated food items into the Sanctuary during the opening of the November 22 worship service.
